DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY

Ardmore Flying School maintains a zero-tolerance approach to drugs and alcohol.

- Smoking is not permitted in any building.
- The possession or distribution of drugs is strictly prohibited.
- Flying and the use of alcohol or drugs do not mix. Drug use is strictly prohibited and may affect your ability to hold a Class 1 Medical.
- Clear rules apply to alcohol consumption. In line with CAA regulations, you must not fly within 8 hours of drinking alcohol ("bottle to throttle"), and your blood alcohol level must be below 0.02.

Ardmore Flying School operates a random drug and alcohol testing programme. From April 2027, the CAA will require us to implement a more formal Drug and Alcohol Management Plan (DAMP). As this develops, we will provide further information.
